Navarna Mantra is the most powerful mantra of Goddess Durga Devi. Navarna Mantra is the basic mantra of the *Shri Durga Saptashati Path*. This mantra has some other names like Chamunda Mantra - Chandi Mantra - Navakshari Mantra. and the Mantra is:-

Who is Goddess Durga?

Goddess Durga is a powerful form of Universal feminine energy. Additionally, Goddess Durga's body is formed with 3 Goddess Powers:-

- 1. Mahasaraswati
- 2. Mahalakshmi
- 3. Mahakali

Navarna Mantra Mantra Meaning

This mantra is created with nine beej mantras. Therefore, we call it Navarna Mantra or Navakshari Mantra. These nine beej mantras are

"Om-Aim-Hreem-Kleem-Cha-Mun-Dayai-Vich-Che".

Find below the full meaning of the Navarna Mantra:

!!! Om Aim Hreem Kleem Chamundayai Vichche !!!

- Om represents The GOD itself, who is unique and one.
- Aim is the Beej Mantra of Goddess Maha Saraswati. Goddess Maha Saraswati is the Goddess of creation. By all means, she filled the devotee's mind with all the knowledge.
- Hreem is another <u>Great Beej Mantra of Goddess Mahalakshmi.</u> Goddess Maha Lakshmi is the Goddess of wealth, fame, good luck, and all worldly affairs. Shreem is one of the chiefly famous beej mantras of Mahalakshmi. Read about <u>Shreem Mantra</u>.
- Kleem is the Mantra of Goddess Mahakali. Goddess Mahakali is the Goddess of fierce power and death. Indeed, the Kleem mantra attracts people toward you.
- Chamundayai is the Mantra of <u>Goddess Chamunda</u> (Durga). She protects the chanter's body, life, and complete self with her blessings.
- Vichche is the Mantra of Divine Consciousness. It helps the chanter to go deep into his/ her self during chanting or meditating.

By Navarna Mantra, we invoke the Supreme God and three different powers of God with passion. We also ask to appear in our lives to fulfill all worldly and spiritual desires.

Good Time to Start Navarna Mantra

Who is Goddess Chandi Devi?

Devi Chandi is one of the most famous Hindu goddesses. Her other name is *Devi Chandika* and she is a form of *Goddess Parvati Devi*. Goddess <u>Chandi</u> is a robust and fierce form of Goddess Parvati Devi. She is born to kill evil powers.

Goddess Chandi is extremely fierce because of her anger. She does not bear evil acts. She kills evildoers without any compassion. Durga Saptashati explained her anger is very well. Devi Chandi is also famous in Sikhism. The tenth Sikh Guru "Shri Guru Gobind Singh" wrote a path called "Chandi Di Var". This path explains the fight between the Gods and the Demons.

The name Chamunda is a combo of two monsters Chanda and Munda. They both are killed by Chamunda Devi. She is a chief Yoginis of a group of 64 yoginis group. Goddess Chamunda is basically a tribal Hindu Goddess and later on entered the Jain pantheon too.

What is Chamunda Mantra?

The **Navarna Mantra** "Om Aim Hreem Kleem Chamundayai Vichche" is basically a real Chamunda Mantra. It consists of the name of **Goddess Chamunda**.
